The Turin Winter School on EU Integration, Law and Justice is hosted by the Law Department of the University of Turin and is part of the 2019-2022 Jean Monnet Module on "EU Mobility and Migration Law", supported by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

The third edition of the Turin Winter School focuses on the role that strategic litigation plays in advancing rights in the area of mobility and migration in Europe. The programme combines theoretical approaches and practical insights.
