



# CALL FOR N. 2 EARLY CAREER FELLOWSHIP GRANTS OPEN POSITION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TURIN – LAW DEPARTMENT

The text in Italian is the official text of the call for all legal intents and purposes and, in the event of nonconformity with the present document, the former takes precedence over the latter.

The Law Department of the University of Turin is offering 2 (two) **Early Career Fellowship Grants** for a period of 3 months each. Each grant amounts to 9.000 € (gross).

Features of research activities
---------------------------------

The research activities entitled to funding shall be carried out between **1 February 2020 and 30 July 2020**, at the Law Department of the University of Turin, under the scientific supervision of Prof. Francesco Costamagna, in charge of the Excellency Programme, and of an appointed supervisor. The research activities shall be performed in accordance with a project proposal submitted by the candidate. The Grant is awarded to support the drawing up of a proposal for a Marie Skłodowska Curie Standard European Fellowship (MSCA EF) to be submitted to the 2020 call of the program, selecting the Law Department of the University of Turin as Beneficiary.

The Scientific Supervisor of the project, together with the Director of the Department and each selected candidate will then appoint a supervisor to provide the necessary training to the researchers.

Requirements
--------------

The call is open to candidates with a University degree or equivalent. Candidates shall be proficient in English.





Candidates must not have resided or carried out their main activities (work, study, etc.) in Italy for more than 12 months in the three years immediately before the MSCA EF application deadline (approximately around 11 September 2020 without prejudice to any change the European Commission decides to introduce), including the three-months period covered by the grant. Preference will be awarded to the candidates who, by the deadline of the call, shall have a phd degree or at least four years of Full Time Equivalent research experience.

Candidates have to register and complete the online application form by 02 December 2019 at 12:00 (GMT +1) at the latest. No other form of submission of the application shall be accepted.

To complete the application, candidates must print the electronic receipt of the submission that is automatically released by email, sign it and send a scanned copy of it to: eccellenza.law@unito.it. The email must have the following subject: "Application Early Career Fellowship". This is an essential step in the process, if omitted it will result in the exclusion of the candidate.

The following documents must be attached to the application:

- 1. a Curriculum Vitae including a list of publications (max. 10);
- 2. a copy of a valid identification document (e.g. ID card released by the State, passport, etc.):

- 4. if earned, a copy of the Ph.D. or 4 years of Full Time Equivalent research experience;

Selection process

The selection process will consist in:

- the evaluation of CV and academic titles;
- an interview, which can be made via Internet, which shall involve the discussion of the research project.

The Evaluation Panel, appointed by the Law Department Board, will award up to 100 points to each candidate, allocated as follow:

the evaluation of academic titles and CV (University Degrees, Ph.D., publications, experiences)	up to 70 points
the interview in which the candidate will discuss his/her project	up to 30 points

A valid identification document (e.g. State issues ID card, passport, etc.) is required for the interview.

<u>Date, time and place</u> of the interview will be published on the website <u>www.dg.unito.it</u> (under "*Bandi* e Borse di studio – Borse di studio"). **No other form of official notifications will be provided**.

The selected candidates and the ranking of all applicants will be published at the following addresses:

Selected candidates will be notified by the competent office and they will have to accept the grant within 5 days from the notification of the results.



The grant consists of an amount of 9.000 € (gross), to be payed in 3 monthly instalments.





The fellowship includes an insurance policy covering personal injury, paid for by the granting Department, in accordance with art. 12 of the "Regulations for the administration and awarding of Scholarship grants".

The grant can be suspended in the case of serious illness or other health impairment that lasts no less than one month and that will have to be certified by a doctor. The grant can be suspended for maternity or paternity leave. Depending on time constraints and the availability of funds, the grant can be maintained during maternity or paternity leave. In such a case, the candidates will have to complete his/her period of research, for the period left, once back to work.

The grant may also be suspended in case of parental leave, in accordance with the rules applicable to doctoral students and fellows of the University of Turin.

The fellowship may not be cumulated with other research grants or fellowships awarded for whatsoever purpose, unless the latter are awarded by domestic or foreign institutions for the purpose of completing abroad the research activities funded by the University of Turin.

The fellowship shall not constitute an employment contract.

The fellowship shall not give rise to unemployment allowances, pension benefits or other social security entitlements.

# Rights and obligations for the fellow

The fellow has the right of accessing the following research facilities of the Department.

He/She has also the right to use all the services available to researchers and professors, in accordance with internal regulations.

While at the facilities provided by the University, the fellow is required to comply with all applicable health and safety regulations.

At the end of the term, the fellow shall present a scientific report on the activities performed, to be submitted to the Director of the Department, together with the Supervisor's evaluation. In case of serious and continued failure by the fellow to comply with the rules, the Scientific Supervisor shall promptly notify the Law Department Board, requesting the exclusion of the fellow and motivating the decision in writing.

The results of the research are the exclusive property of the University of Turin. Any disclosure or publication of the research's results needs to be approved by the Director of the Department of Law and has to mention the partnership with the University of Turin.
