EARLY CAREER FELLOWSHIP GRANTS
5 OPEN POSITIONS AT THE
UNIVERSITY OF TURIN – LAW DEPARTMENT

This document in English is to be considered as a courtesy summary of the main provisions of the CALL DG/BDR 24/2021 - deadline on 3rd December 2021 at 6.00 p.m. (CET time), which is available in Italian at the following links:

The Italian version of the call is legally binding for all intents and purposes.

The Law Department of the University of Turin is offering **5 (five) Early Career Fellowship Grants** for a research period of **3 months** each. The gross salary for any single position is **€9,510**.

Features of the research activities

The research activities entitled to funding shall be carried out:

- between 1st March and 14th September 2022;
- at the Law Department of the University of Turin;
- under the scientific supervision of an appointed Professor of the Law Department (please refer to the “Application” section below).

The Grant is awarded to support the **mandatory drawing up of a proposal for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions - European Postdoctoral Fellowship (HE MSCA PF)** to be submitted to the 2022 Call of the Programme, selecting the Law Department of the University of Turin as Beneficiary.

Requirements

Applicant researchers must meet all eligibility criteria required to apply for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions European Fellowship (please refer to Horizon Europe Programme Guide for Applicants Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions - European Postdoctoral Fellowships, Version 1.0-2021):

Nationality: any;

Mobility: the researcher cannot have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies etc) in Italy for more than 12 months (including the present 3 Months fellowship) in the 36 months immediately prior to the call deadline;

Doctoral Degree: maximum 8 years from date of award of the (first) doctoral degree at the HEMSCA-PF call deadline (tentative date 11/09/2022). This limit can be extended (in days) for maternity leave, paternity leave, research in a non-associated TC, compulsory national service, time spent not working in research, long-term sick leave (see Horizon Europe Programme Guide for Applicants Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions - European Postdoctoral Fellowships, Version 1.0-2021).

Candidates shall be **proficient in English**.

Application

By 3rd December 2021 at 6.00 p.m. (CET time), candidates must **i) complete** the online application form, **ii) print** the electronic receipt of the online application form, received by email, **iii) sign it** and **iv) send a scanned copy to: eccellenza.law@unito.it**, e-mail subject: “Application ECF 2021”.

No other form of submission of the application shall be accepted.

The following documents must be attached to the application (PDF):

1. a *Curriculum Vitae*
2. a list of **max 10** publications;
3. a copy of a valid identification document;
4. the **research proposal** (Annex 1).

Candidates with degrees/PhDs in languages other than Italian, English, French, German, or Spanish are kindly requested to translate them into Italian or English.

Candidates are invited to identify and contact a possible Supervisor among the Professors of the Department of Law in view of the project they will present in the Call MSCA 2022. To this end, the candidates may attach a letter of commitment to the research project (Annex 2 of this Notice).

Evaluation

The Evaluation Panel, appointed by the Law Department, will be announced after the deadline by publication at the following link: (www.dg.unito.it),

Scoring must be in the range from 0-100. Half marks may be given.

- Up to 70 points for Academic titles (Degrees, PhDs), publications and CV
- Up to 30 points for the interview focussed on the proposed project.

Within these limits, the Evaluation Panel will establish the criteria for assigning points to qualifications and to the interview, as well as the **threshold** for admission to the interview and for eligibility in the final ranking.

A valid identification document is required for the interview.

The date, time and web platform of the online interview will be published on the website www.dg.unito.it (under “Il Dipartimento – Bandi e selezioni – Borse di studio di ricerca”). **No other form of official notifications will be provided.**

Selected candidates will be notified by e-mail, and they must accept the grant **within 5 days from the notification of the results.**

In case of waiver, the fellowship can be assigned to eligible competitors according to the order of the ranking.

Features of the fellowship

The scholarship amounts to €9,510 gross, paid in 3 deferred monthly instalments.

The fellowship shall not:

- constitute an employment contract;
- give rise to unemployment allowances, pension benefits or other social security entitlements;
- be cumulated with other research grants or fellowships awarded for whatsoever purpose.

The fellowship includes an insurance policy covering personal injury, in accordance with art. 9 of the “Regulations for the administration and awarding of Scholarship grants”.

The scholarship can be suspended in the case of serious illness (no less than one month), certified by a doctor. The grant can be suspended for maternity or paternity leave. Depending on time constraints and the availability of funds, the grant can be maintained during maternity or paternity leave. In such a case, the candidates must complete their remaining research period, once they are back to work. The grant may also be suspended in case of parental leave, in accordance with the rules applicable to doctoral students and fellows of the University of Turin.

Rights and obligations for the fellow

The fellow has the right to access the research facilities of the Department and to use all the services available to researchers and teachers in accordance with the internal regulations.

While at the facilities provided by the University, the fellow is required to comply with all applicable health and safety regulations.

At the end of the term, the fellow shall present a scientific report on the activities performed, to be submitted to the Director of the Department, together with the Supervisor’s evaluation. In case of serious and continued failure by the fellow to comply with the rules, the Scientific Supervisor shall promptly notify the Law Department Board, requesting the exclusion of the fellow and giving the reasons for the decision in writing.

In addition, the fellows **are required to submit** a Marie Skłodowska Curie Standard European Fellowship (**HE MSCA EF**) **project** in the **2022 Call** indicating the Department of Law of the University of Turin as Beneficiary.

The research results are the exclusive property of the University of Turin. Any disclosure or publication of them must be approved by the Director of the Department of Law and must mention the partnership with the University of Turin.

Protection of personal data
